



## **General Aviation Student Checkride Policy**

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Company Check Ride policy for General Aviation students that are not enrolled in American Airlines Cadet Program, Coast Academy, or the Airline Career Training Program.

1. Due to the number of FAA check rides required for adequate throughput of students enrolled at CFT, students not enrolled in one of the 3 programs listed above, will be required to schedule their own FAA check ride.
  - a. If a CFT Checkride becomes available before the students scheduled checkride, CFT might allow a non-program student to be scheduled in lieu of a program student.
  - b. If a CFT program student needs the CFT checkride after the non-program student has been scheduled for it, the non-program student will be “bumped” back to the checkride they originally scheduled.
- 2. Students will be required to pass an End of Course event before scheduling their check ride regardless if they are training Part 61 or Part 141**
3. General Aviation students will be allowed to use CFT facilities and aircraft for their check ride.
4. General Aviation students must communicate their scheduled checkride date and time if booked on their own, to the Site Assistant Chief Flight Instructor William Hutchings, along with their respective Scheduler and Instructor for proper planning of resources and instructor time.
